Providing annual school supplies



Each year, during the visit of our donors and sponsors, students typically receive school supplies, including notebooks, pens, backpacks, and uniforms. The new academic year begins in early November. This period marks the public launch of the school year, after which students attend their regular classes and often participate in an additional evening session at DCC. In addition, DCC offers supplementary classes in English, Khmer, and computer science. These programs are provided free of charge, enabling students to enhance their learning opportunities.

This year, with support from HELP Cambodia, DCC has expanded opportunities for children in impoverished conditions to study English at no cost. Approximately 50 students are benefiting from this program, the majority of whom are migrants from rural areas, and all classes are taught by our volunteers. Due to their family circumstances, these families have relocated to the community in search of employment in Phnom Penh to support their households. They have recently settled in rental accommodations near the school. After regular classes, the students may attend additional sessions at DCC, including Khmer, English, and computer studies. All of these children require sponsorship to continue their education through high school and university. We hope that many sponsors will come forward so that DCC can sustain and expand its efforts in the years ahead.
