DCC – Phnom Penh

The DCC is our main school in Phnom Penh. It continues to prosper through the Sponsorship Program. In the last 12 months, enrolled students have increased from 92 to 124. Sponsorship support has grown from 52 to 62 sponsored children, with more sponsors on the horizon. Bophal now receives just under \$2000AUD per month and is able to pay teachers, buy school supplies, provide educational equipment and best of all educate a group of young people who may not receive an education if it wasn't for the DCC.

Wollundry Rotary and Rotary District 9700 have again helped with a few projects this year.

Wollundry Rotary and HELP added a roof and airconditioning to keep the computers safe and functional.
